A SLIGHTLY CONVERGING TREND FROM PREVIOUS LPI SURVEYS IN 2007, 2010, AND 2012 IS ALSO FOUND

IN 2014, WITH LOWER PERFORMING COUNTRIES IMPROVING THEIR OVERALL LPI SCORES MORE THAN




